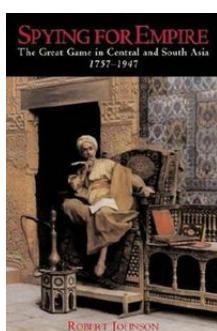


SPYING FOR EMPIRE: THE GREAT GAME IN CENTRAL AND SOUTH ASIA 1757-1947
