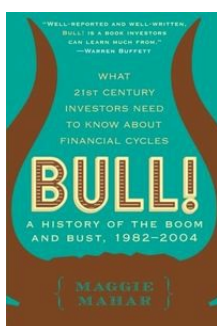


BULL: A HISTORY OF THE BOOM AND BUST, 1982-2004
