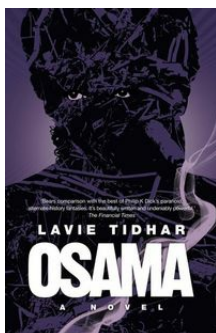


OSAMA
