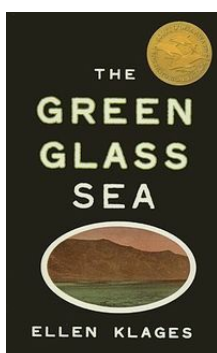


THE GREEN GLASS SEA
