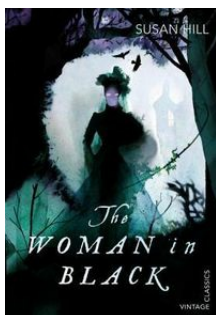


THE WOMAN IN BLACK
